



Dear Roger Clap Families,

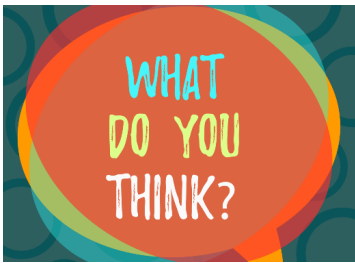
Join our school community TONIGHT (February 25) at 6pm [on Zoom](#) for our monthly School Site Council Meeting. All families are welcome!
